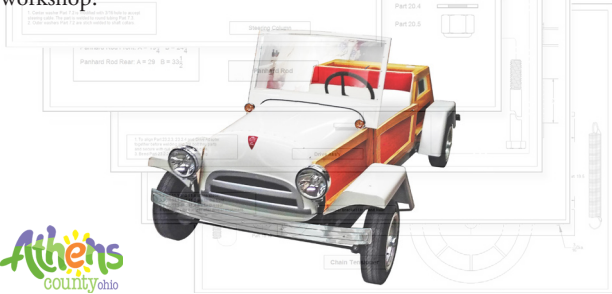

Build You Own King Midget

Rumors have persisted since 1969 that someone was going to put King Midgets back into production. And with 2016 that time has arrived! Midget Motors believed in engineering simplicity efficiency – King Midgets had only 88 moving parts and car owners were generally able to solve problems on the fly. But what about building a King Midget? Veteran King Midget engineers and designers have developed complete plans to allow a competent craftsman to build a reproduction two-seater Model II just like Midget Motors Inc. made them in 1955. To prove it a brand new home-built King Midget called the King Midget Club Car will be introduced during the 2016 King Midget Jamboree.

Joining in the fun will be Ohio University’s Digital Games and Animation faculty and students who will animate the building of a King Midget digitally as the actual reproduction building process unfolds.

THE KING MIDGET

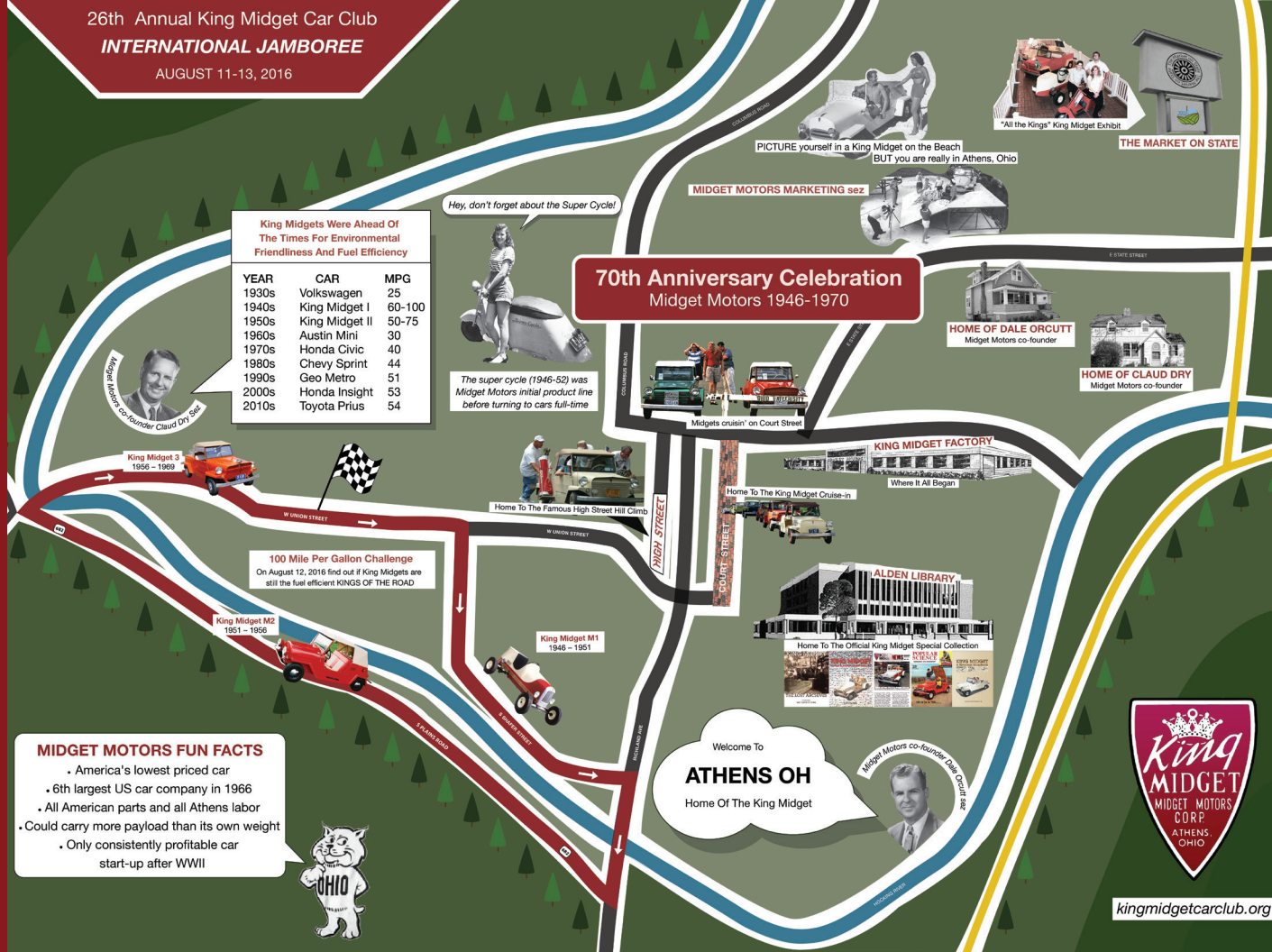
Midget Motors Co. was founded in Athens, Ohio in 1946 and made the King Midget car, which by the 1960s had grown into the 6th largest car company in the US. The diminutive vehicles, which appeal to fans of all ages, have a loyal following of car owners and aficionados that will converge on Athens August 11-13, 2016 for the King Midget Jamboree commemorating the 60th anniversary of the cars debut.

This summer's King Midget Jamboree is the 26th straight year that the event has been held with Athens last hosting the event in 2006. Many events are open to the public, including the 100 mile per gallon challenge, the grand opening of the official King Midget archives in Ohio University's Alden Library Special Collections, and a cruise-in and party on Court Street. Ohio University's Alden Library, within its Mahn Center for Archives and Special Collections, will be home to the permanent collection of Midget Motors history and memorabilia with the grand opening of the exhibit Friday, August 12th in conjunction with the 26th Annual King Midget Jamboree. The special collection will provide King Midget researchers, scholars, and enthusiasts a comprehensive, permanent archives that will include all original letters, historical documents, and exhibit materials of Midget Motors. The grand opening will include a ribbon cutting, tour of the exhibit by curator Doug McCabe, reflections from donors of historical items, and refreshments. The agreement with the Ohio University Library calls for dedicated space for the Midget Motors archives as well as periodic King Midget exhibits and displays. The King Midget Car Club will be working with the library to assure that the collection is authentic, relevant and appropriate to the history of Midget Motors. Donations of Midget Motors materials are welcomed, and any duplicates or items not deemed satisfactory will be returned to the donor. If accepted, items will become a permanent part of the Ohio University Mahn Center's collections.
