Today, I took the steering wheel off (easy—it was loose) and cleaned off all the paint in my bead blasting cabinet because it was severely chipped. There were two layers of paint on the wheel, one white and one black. The white may have been an adhesion promoter, it was difficult to remove. Once the wheel was clean, several cracks became evident. I will get a steering wheel repair kit from Eastwood Co. and get it in shape. Once that's done I'll need to determine the correct color. Do you happen to know? **Ed Werick.**

The steering wheel was originally off-white—about the same color as the KM body, but those steering wheels came from their manufacturer painted white in their normal shade.
