

My original busted and I got a replacement from Midget Motors Supply. I don't know if Paul G. has them or not, but I got a pair thinking Don needed one and still have it. I'll stick it in an envelope and mail it. There's an article on the installation in Shop Notes (J-15) but I need to write a follow-up. The MMS wire is a poor design, having kinks instead of a smooth curve. Worse yet, because it lacks temper or something; it pulls out of the drive hole. I had to add a cotter pin to keep it tucked in there. Now it works fine. Bob
