You can get a 12 oz. aerosol can from W.W. Grainger for about ten bucks.

Available: Scott Olene has found an electronic replacement timer body for the Wisconsin. A Pertronix part D11-18A that sells for about \$178 for the 6v system. They also have it for the 12v.
